'The Ranjitsinhji Swimming Bath' (1870's)

'It is proposed, with the strong approval of the Principal of the Rajkumar College, Mr. C. Mayne, to erect a Swimming Bath for the use and convenience of the boys. It is not necessary to point out what a boon this would be to a public school of such importance both from a hygienic and utilitarian point of view.

It is estimated that the total cost of the Swimming Bath and the Club Premises would be forty thousand rupees. We feel there ought to be no difficulty whatsoever in collecting this sum with the earnest support of the numerous Kathiawar States and those outside it, whose Chiefs and Bhayats owe such splendid advantages of education and culture to the College'.

'The foundation of both Primary and Secondary Education was laid at one and the same time in the year 1853. The Chiefs began to take an interest in the general cause of Education and schools began to multiply in the Province of Kathiawar. On the publication of the great Educational Despatch of the Court of Directors of the East India Company in 1854, the education of the people was definitely declared to be a duty of the State, and a sustained effort was therefore made to provide for Primary Instruction'.

It was decided that a Gymnasium and Pavilion should be presented to the College by the Past and Present students and named after him.

The necessary expenses of the construction will amount to Rs. 10,000. The Chiefs and Kumars are earnestly requested to contribute liberally towards the fund'.

## 'The North Wing' (1870's)

'The Squadron did escort duty for distinguished visitors to the College. As early as 1879, Mr. Macnaghten and his nineteen Prince Pupils, dressed in the uniform of Probyn's Horse - black tunic, red girdle, Afghan turban, white Bedford cord breeches, long boots - escorted His Excellency Sir Richard Temple to his Residency. Those who are escorted by the Kumars are Governors of Bombay, the highest Political Officer in Kathiawar; and any distinguished visitor.

The greatest honour was accorded to the Squadron in 1905, when they escorted the Prince of Wales, who later became King Emperor George V, on his visit to Bombay'.
