RECOGNITION CERTIFICATE

Under the Rights of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the provisions under this the rules of 2012 for the Rights of Children of Gujarat for Free and Compulsory Education, this Recognition Certificate (which is herein referred as "Certificate" afterwards) is issued with the below mentioned conditions to The Manager, Rajkumar College, Rajkot for Class-1 to 8 for the period of 3 years JUNE - 2021 to MAY - 2024 The recognition is with the following conditions:

1. The School Committee will be responsible to complete and maintain the conditions pertaining to the recognition of the School.
2. The School Committee will be responsible to observe all the provisions of the Rights of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Rights of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2012 and the Gujarat Primary Education Act, 1947 and Mumbai Primary Education Rules, 1949 and to observe and maintain all the provisions of Primary Education Rules 1949.
3. The School Committee will be responsible to observe the Act and the rules framed under it and in addition to it, for the rules, regulations, resolutions, circulars, instructions, etc. declared by the State Government time to time.
4. The School should give admission to the children of the weaker section and the children of the deprived group in Class- I including Pre- primary classes as per 25% of the numbers of that class and should provide free and compulsory primary education till it is completed. Regarding its execution the concerned office should have to be contacted.
5. To collect Capitation fee is prohibited and so the Trust Committee or the School should not collect the Capitation fee or donation in any other way or any goods or things in lieu of such fee.
6. For the purpose of providing admission in the School no any screening test on the child or his or her parents or any other practice be adopted.
7. For lack of any proof of age or on the basis of religion, caste, creed, race, place of birth or on any such basis the school should not deny admission to the child.
8. The School should ensure that:
 - 1) Any child who is admitted should not be detained in any class except in Class 6 and in Class 8 till the primary education is completed in the School or nor removed from the School or action he taken for promotion as per current rules.
 - 2) No any child will be subject to physical or mental torture.
 - 3) After completion of the primary education, each child should be awarded Certificate as mentioned under Rule-30.
 - 4) As per provisions in the Act, admissions should have to be given to the students of special requirements which are weak.
 - 5) Those teachers be recruited who have educational qualifications as prescribed by the
 - 6) Government time to time.

- 7) The ratio of teacher to the students should be as per rules. The area of the class-room in the School should be as per rules and should have all the necessary physical facilities.
- 8) The teacher should fulfill his duties as specified under the Sub Section (1) of Section 24 of the Act.
- 9) The guidelines and orders issued by the Central Government or the State Government or
- 10) the Regulator should be observed and followed transparently and impartially for the admission process.
- 11) The School should provide education on the basis of the study-process as per the course prepared by the proper Authority.
- 12) The School should provide admission to the students on the basis of the Section 19 of the Act as per the available facilities in the School.
- 13) The School should maintain the level and criteria specified and mentioned in the Section 19 and specifically the maintenance of the website of the School which provides the information and to follow each year all the conditions of Rule-13 for filing up true and reliable details in DISE, District Information System for Education.
- 14) There should not be unauthorized running of classes within the School premises or outside the School in the same name.
- 15) The School building or other constructions or the ground should be used only for the purposes of development of Educational skill.
- 16) The School should run under the Society Registration Act- 1860 (the Society registered in 21" of 1860 and in 1952 or any rule formed by the Society Company which is in force at that time.
- 17) The School cannot run for profit of any person, group or a society of the persons or any other persons.
- 18) The accounts should be audited and certified by the Chartered Accountant and proper Account Statements should be prepared as per the rules. A copy of the Audited report of the Account Statements should be sent to the competent Authority.
- 19) The facility of recording with the CCTV cameras should be available and the competent Authority should be insured in this regard.
- 20) The School should take necessary steps for safety within the prescribed time-limit as per the guidelines issued by National Disaster Management Authority. The School Safety Policy-2016 should be followed.
- 21) For the security of students and the staff necessary steps should be taken time to time and in that way their safety should be ensured.
- 22) The School Society should not pressurize or impose to students' wards for the purchase of specific types of books, materials, uniform or boots for students from their own institution or any other specific institution or agency or of any specific mark of any company.
- 23) The rules and regulations framed under Gujarat Self-financed Schools (Regulation of Fees) Act, 2017 will be applicable on the School and it should furnish the guarantee bond to follow the same.
- 24) The Competent Authority or the person authorized by him and the Inspector/ Officer of the Education Department will have liberty to inspect the School.
- 25) The School should only use the study-process and the course-books approved by the Government time to time.
- 26) The Education fee and the salary scale of the educational and non-educational employees should be approved by the Government.
- 27) The records, statistical statements and the certificates issued by the Principal or the Directors should be reliable.
- 28) The School will provide such reports and information as instructed time to time by the Regulator and the Competent Authority and to fulfill the condition of recognition to continue the school or to remove the shortcomings of the working of the School and for it will follow the orders issued by the State Government/ local Authority.
- 29) There will not be any change in the name of the School, place of the School or in the management system of the School without pre permission from the Competent Authority.


- 30) The School should start in the same year in which the approval is granted to the School. If the School is not started within six months after granting the permission, then the permission granted will be liable, automatic for rejection.
- 31) When it is necessary the School-building should have to be provided by the School-Directors for the use of Public Examinations and for the purposes of General Public.
- 32) All Resolutions, Circulars/ Information Rules issued by the government time to time should have to be followed.
- 33) The conditions should be followed completely as per recognition of New Private Primary School/decrease class and for the increase in classes.
- 34) All the provisions mentioned in Gujarat Primary Education Act 1947 and Primary Education Rules-1949 for School-Management Education and Evaluation and related to the private schools should be followed.
- 35) The conditions mentioned in the Schedule F of Gujarat Primary Education Rules -1949 should be followed.
- 36) The provisions contained in RTE Act-2009 & RTE Rules- 2012 should be followed.
- 37) This approval is issued considering that it is on the Revenue and other true basis. If in future any basis which is issued found to be false, then those Organizing association will be considered as responsible and it should be noted that the government will have authority to take any steps including police complaint against them.
